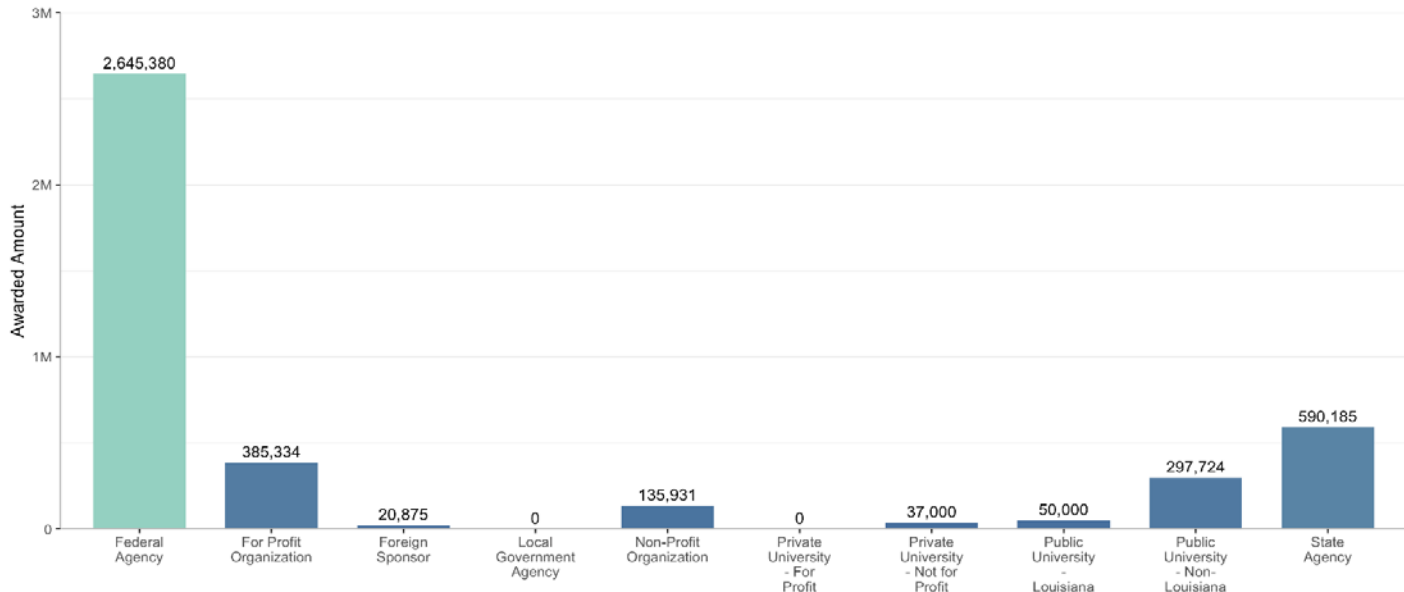

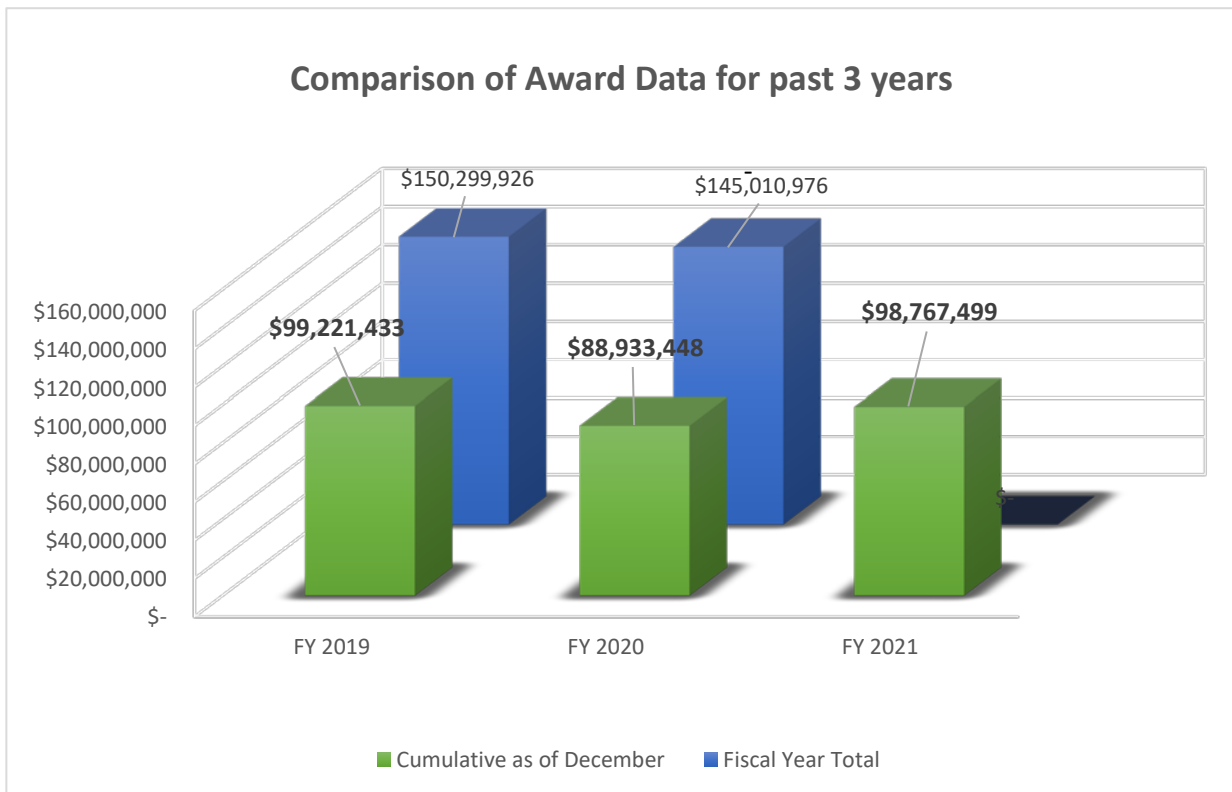
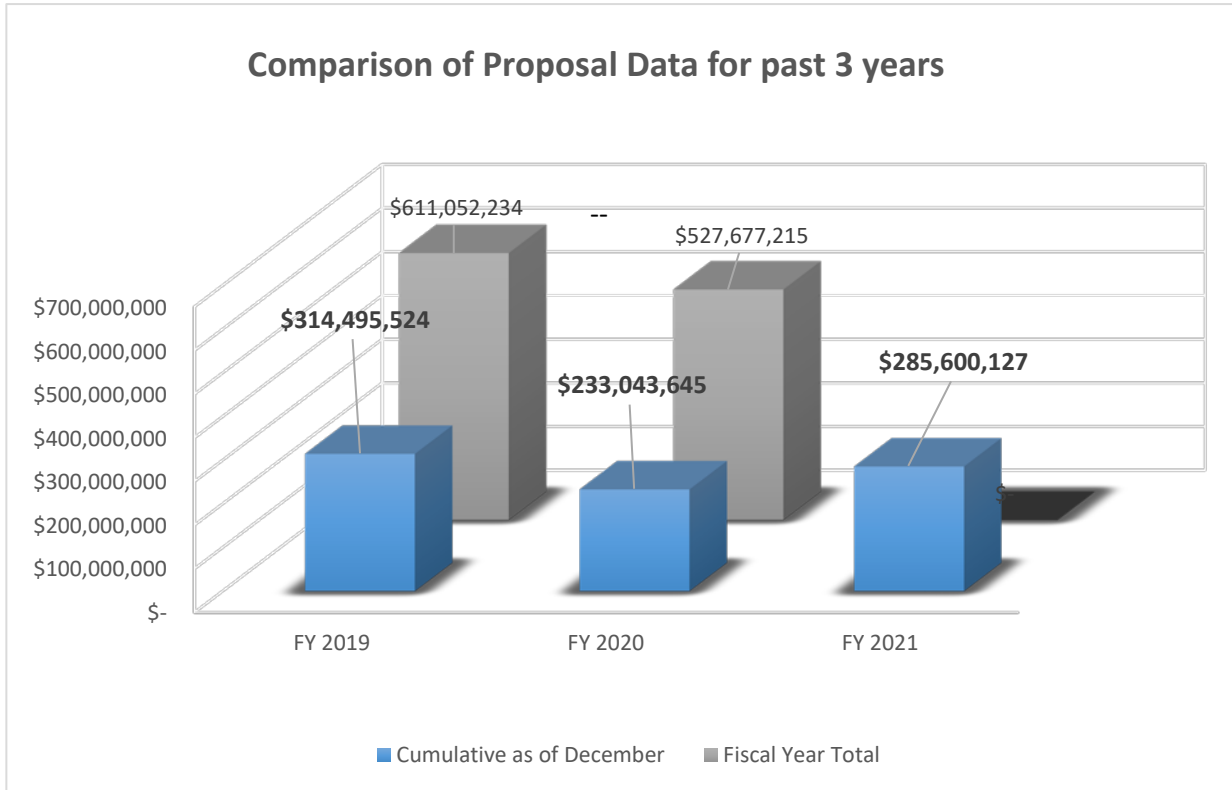

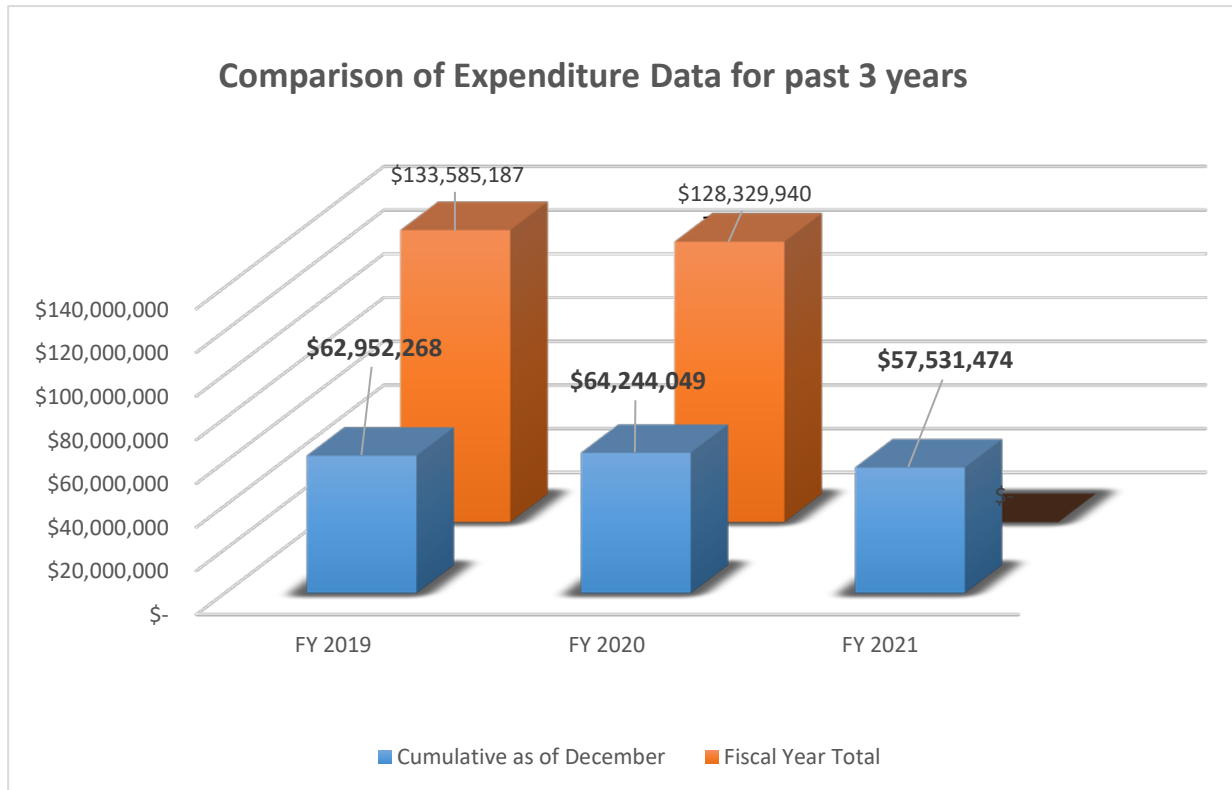

Comparison of Proposal & Award & Expenditure Data for past 3 years

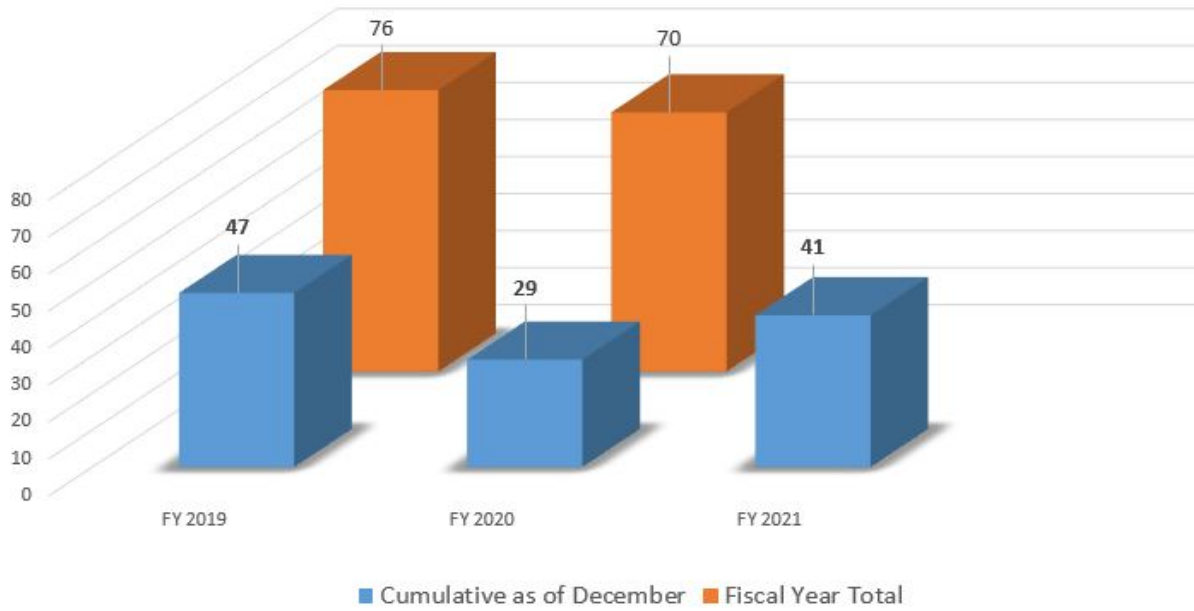




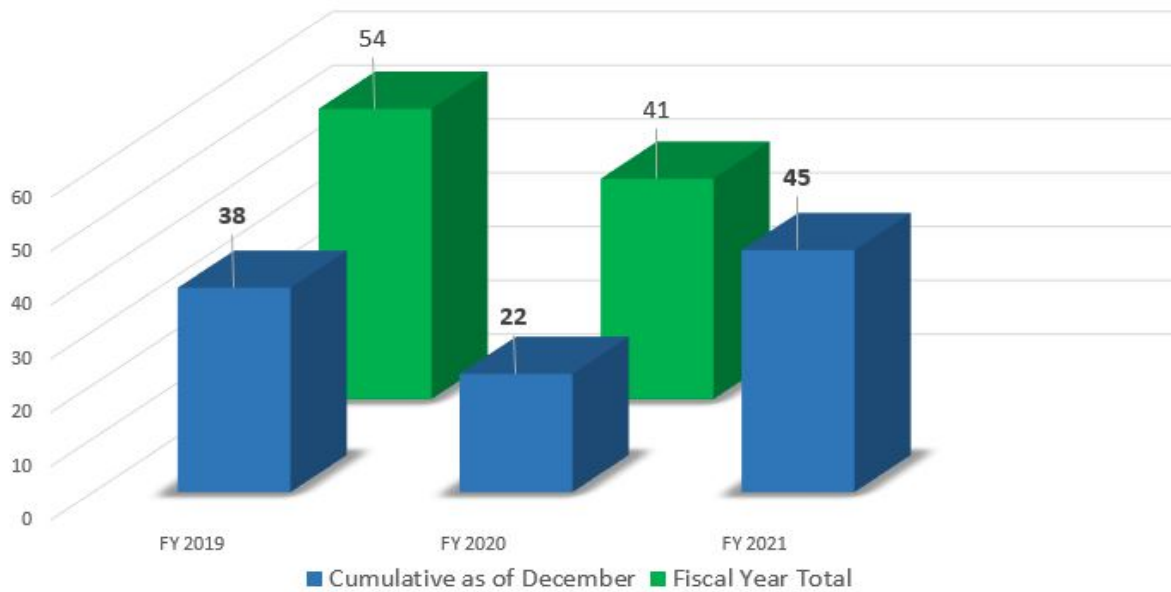

Comparison of Invention & Patent & Revenue for past 3 years

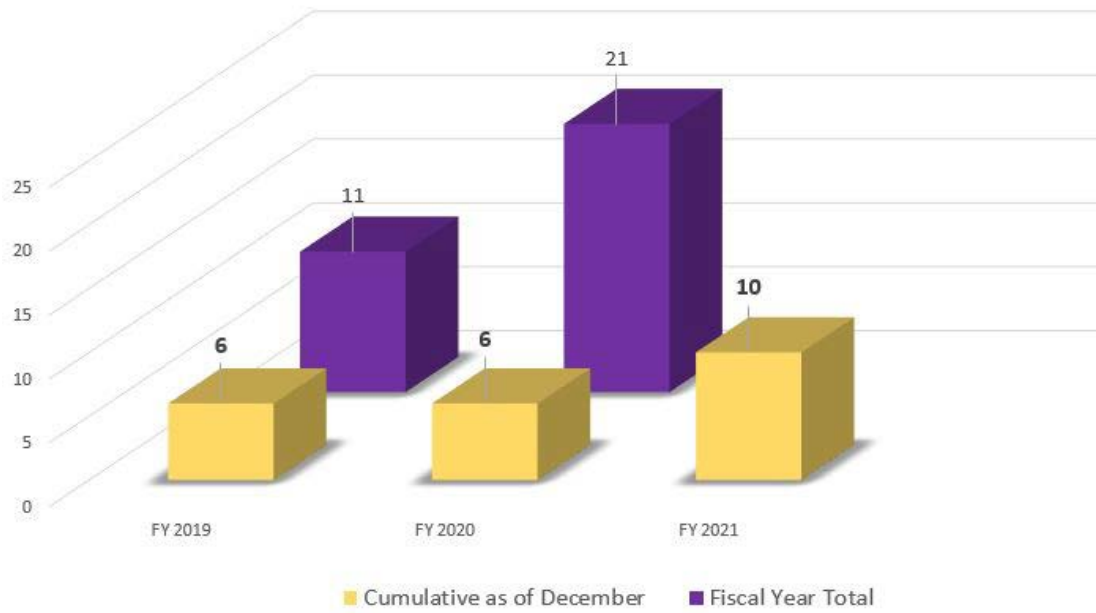
Comparison of Invention Disclosures
