The second meeting of the Ad Hoc Faculty Senate GAI Committee Meeting convened at 3:06 pm on March 14, 2025, in room 251 of Music and Dramatic Arts Building at the LSU campus, with the Chair and the Secretary being present. There were no public comments.

Osborn moved to approve the minutes from the meeting on 7 March 2025. Motion carried.

Osborn made a motion to suspend the agenda and a take up the presentation on GAI by Bazayev and Osborn as the first business. The motion was approved.

Bazayev and Osborn gave a presentation on “What Are the Pros and Cons of GAI?” The presentation was followed by a discussion. Points of further consideration: i. Rethinking teaching methods to avoid misuse; ii. Committee’s role as supporting faculty whether they choose to adopt GAI or not; and iii. Establishing guidelines to govern GAI usage in teaching and research.

The committee then discussed Unfinished Business on syllabus statements. Singh introduced the Boston University GAI Assistance Policy as a model. It was followed by a discussion. Singh made a motion that the Committee will focus on the curriculum using GAI. Motion passed unanimously.

The Committee then discussed GAI in Curriculum Development as the next item of business. Singh discussed policies from Boston University and encouraged everyone to review the policies before the next meeting. As actionable items, the committee also discussed drafting a faculty development course or workshop with GAI and potential invites to GAI committee meeting. Singh made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 4:15pm. The motion was approved unanimously.
